- 1. To review the minutes and action taken report on previous IQAC minutes
  - i. IQAC has given the targets for the academic year 2023-24 viewing the attainments of the previous year and assessing the strengths and weakness of all departments
  - ii. New Curriculum and model question papers were framed for PVP 23 regulations for first year subjects as per the guidelines of JNTUK
  - iii. Induction program for first year students was organised as per the guidelines of AICTE
  - iv. Library orientation Programme is planned in December 2023 to first years
  - v. Anti ragging week was observed form 12/08/2023 to 18/08/2023 and all the departments organised various events during the week and submitted the report to Anti ragging cell
  - vi. First semester subjects feedback for II, III and IV year was collected and was found to be satisfactory
  - vii. Heads are informed about the Student feedback in Student Satisfaction Survey and an action plan was taken

- a. The placement percentage in all departments is low compared to the same period in the previous academic year
- b. The number of high packages in all the departments are very less
- c. CSE and MBA departments have signed new MOUs in the current academic year. Heads of the remaining branches are requested to focus on the MoUs
- d. Heads of ME, MBA are informed to plan the one week / two week FDPs that are suitable to their disciplines
- e. Heads of CSE, ECE, EEE, IT and MBA are requested to send the students to Industrial visits
- f. Heads of CE, CSE, EEE and ME are suggested to improve the alumni activities
- g. Department of CE, need to focus on journal publications
- h. All the department heads are requested to review the status of various patents

- i. Faculty acting as resource persons is zero in departments of CSE, ECE, EEE and ME
- j. All the heads are advised to encourage the faculty to attend FDPs and workshops by utilizing financial support from the institution
- k. Faculty certifications are zero in ECE and MBA
- I. Department heads of CE, CSE, ECE, IT and ME are advised to motivate the faculty concern to apply for R&D projects to various govt. and non govt. agencies
- m. Departments of CSE, ECE, and IT are requested to focus on opportunities to generate consultancy.
- n. Student participation in premier institutes is very low in all the departments except EEE

- q. All the department heads have to concentrate on the student internships providing stipend
- r. Student publications are zero in all the departments
- s. The heads of CSE and ECE branches are requested to identify the online coding platforms helpful for the students in campus placements
- t. All the department heads are requested to educate the students about various scholarship schemes available to them
- u. Student Professional body member ships in CE, CSE and MBA are zero
