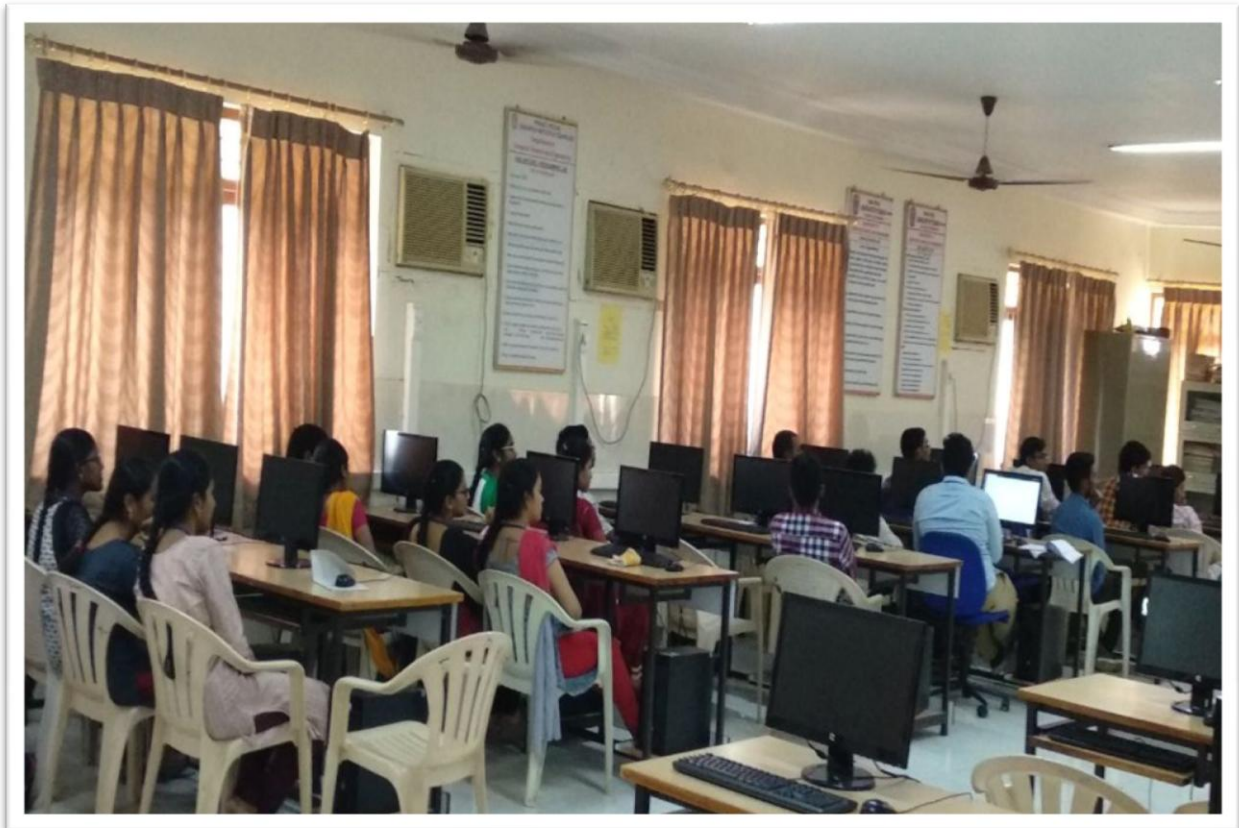
3. BHUDAR PROGRAMME

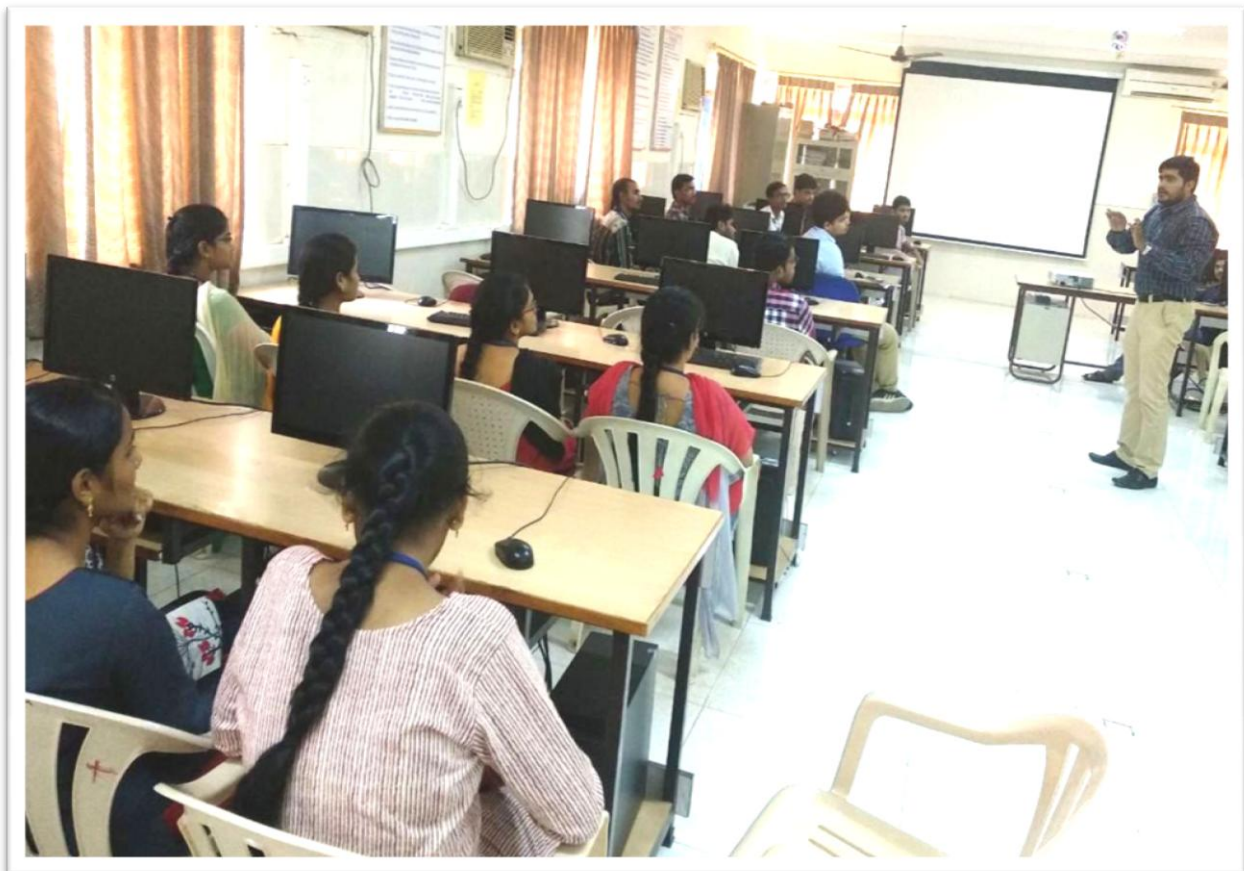

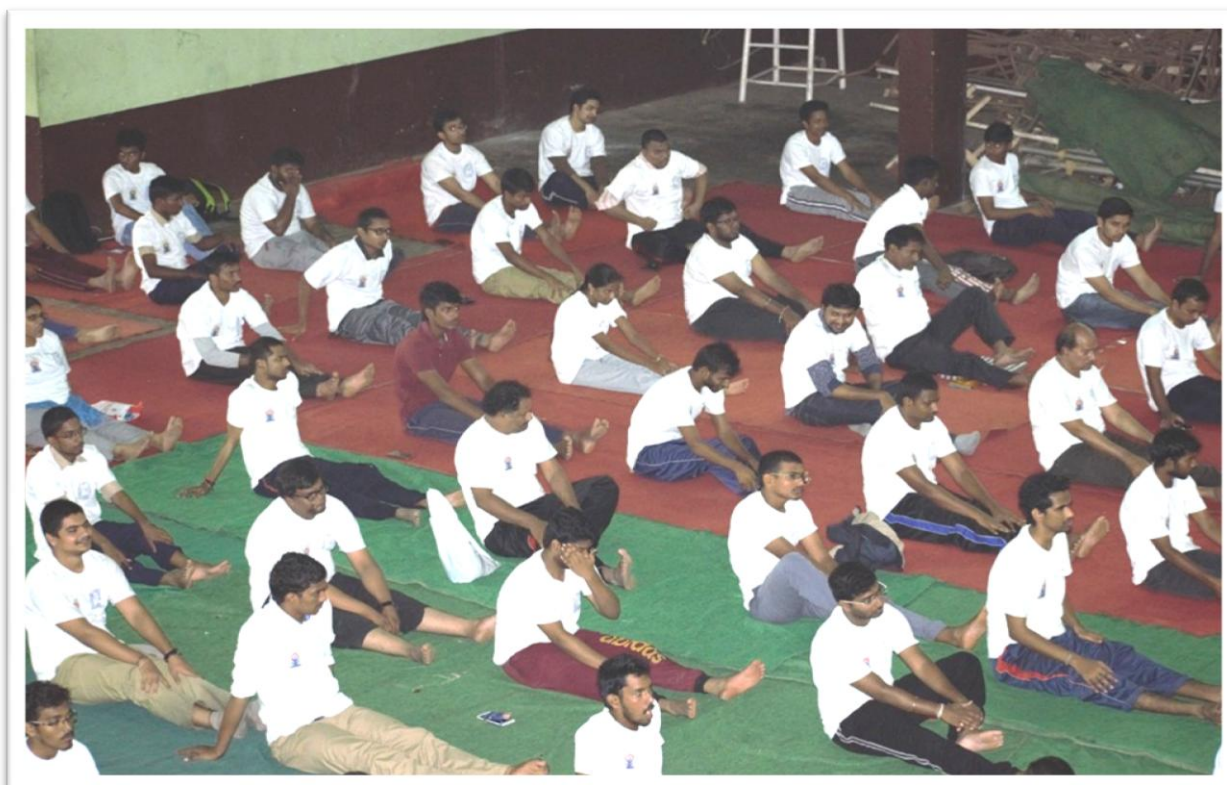

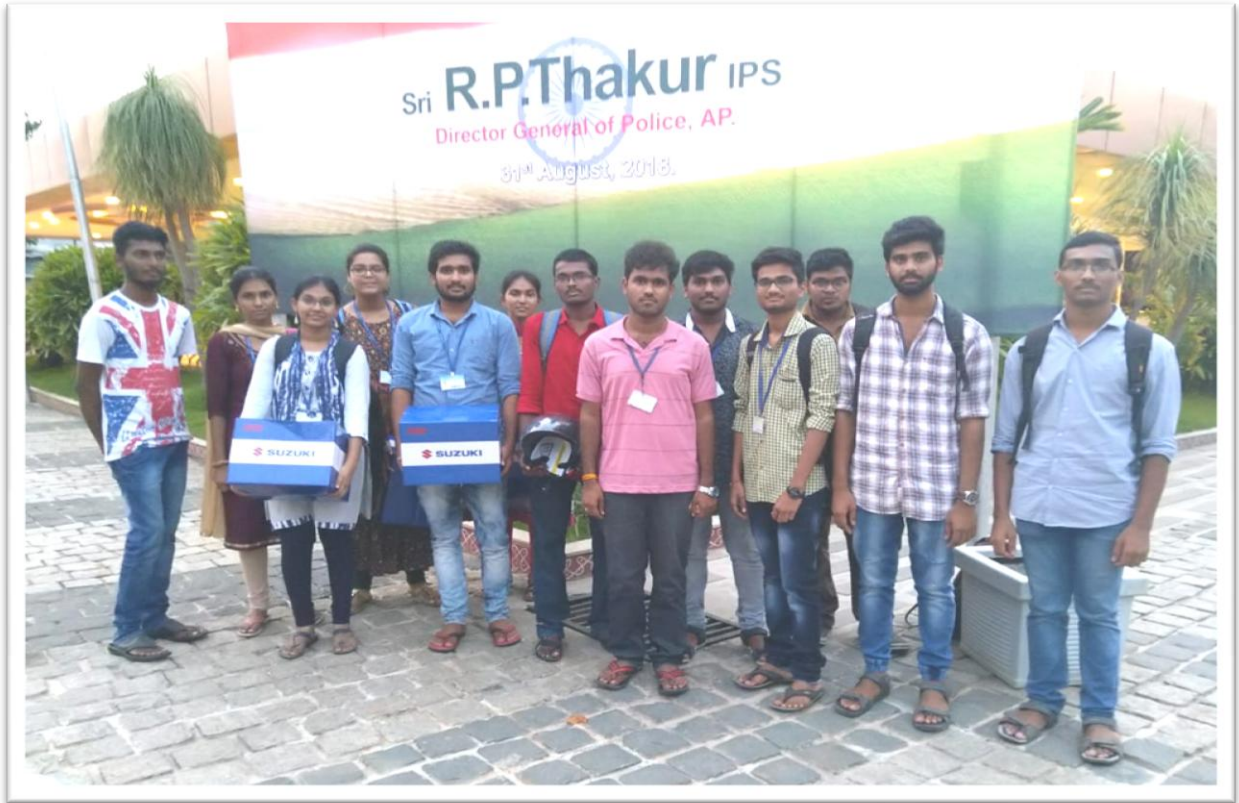

20. MAHATMA GANDHI VARDHANTHI

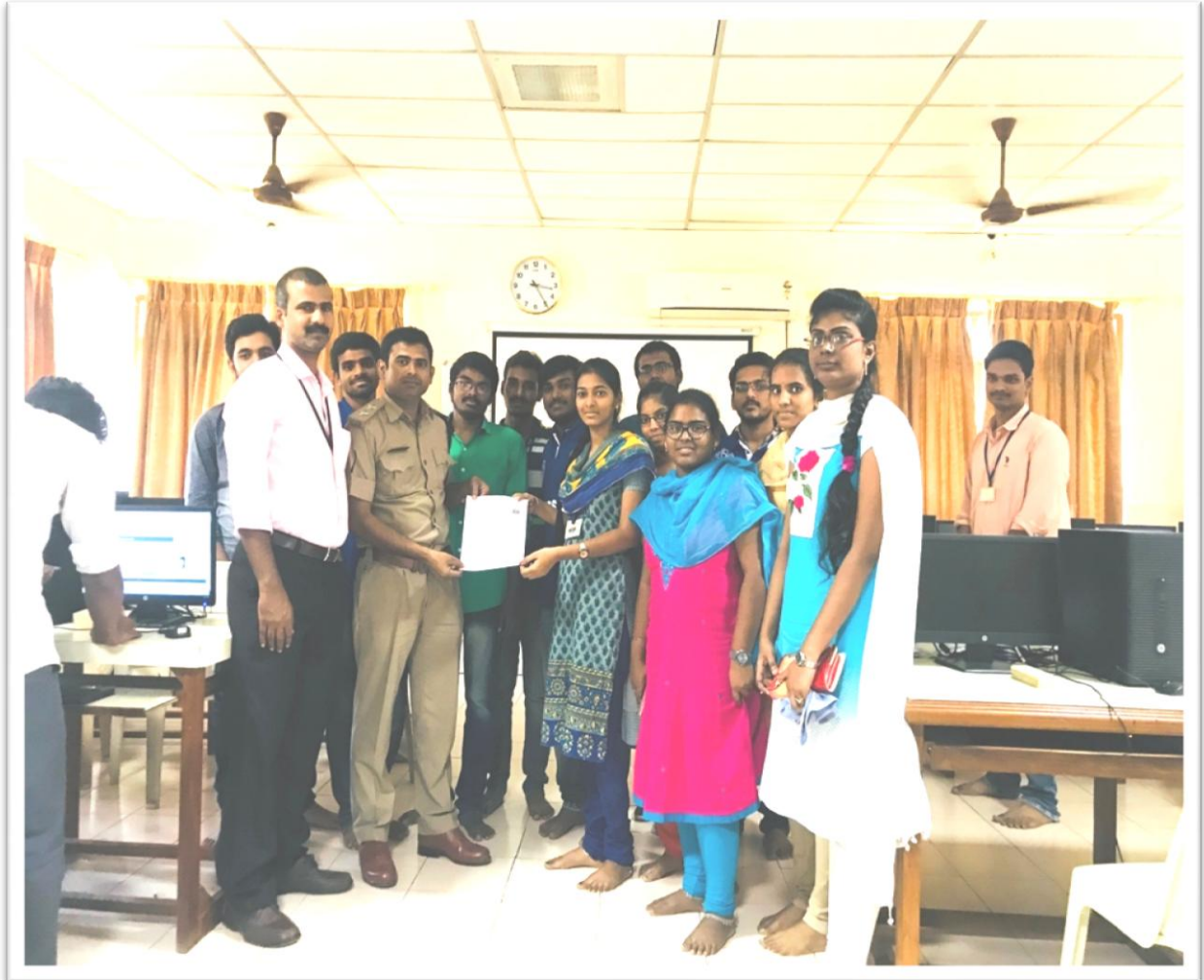

21. LLR MELA

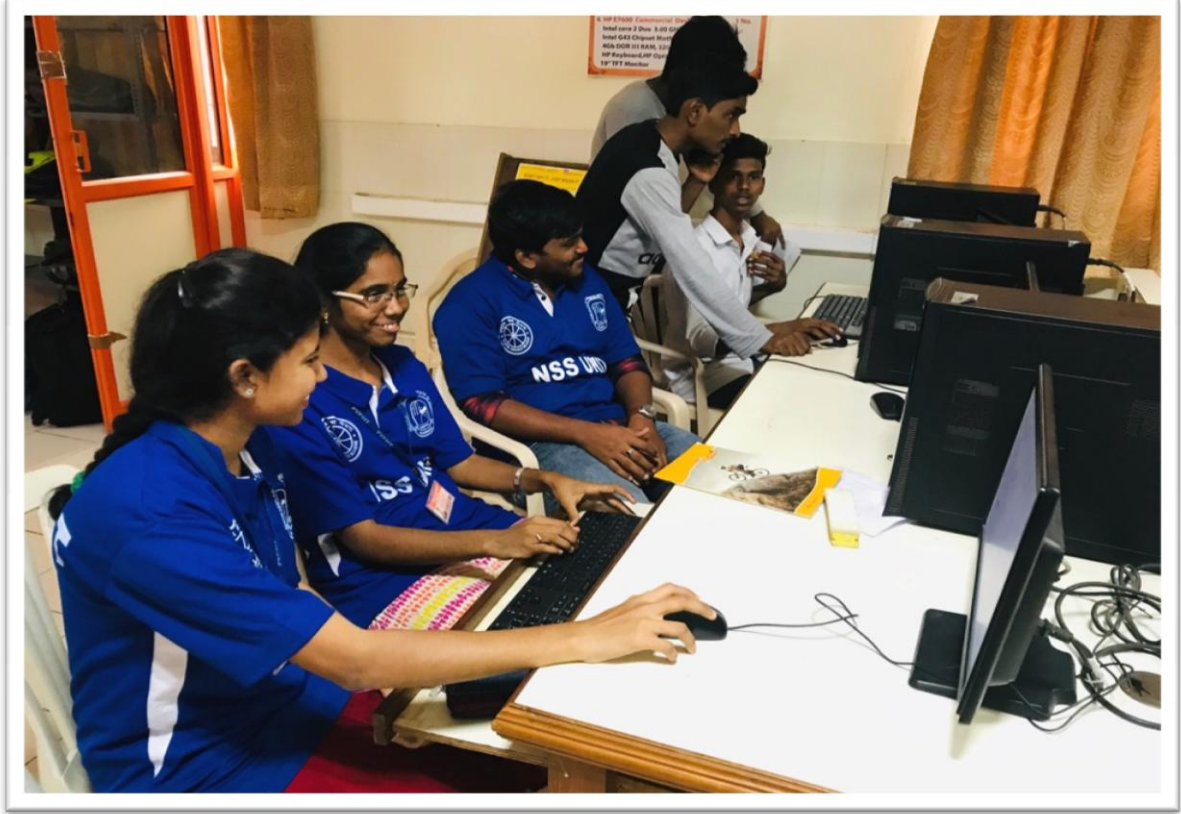

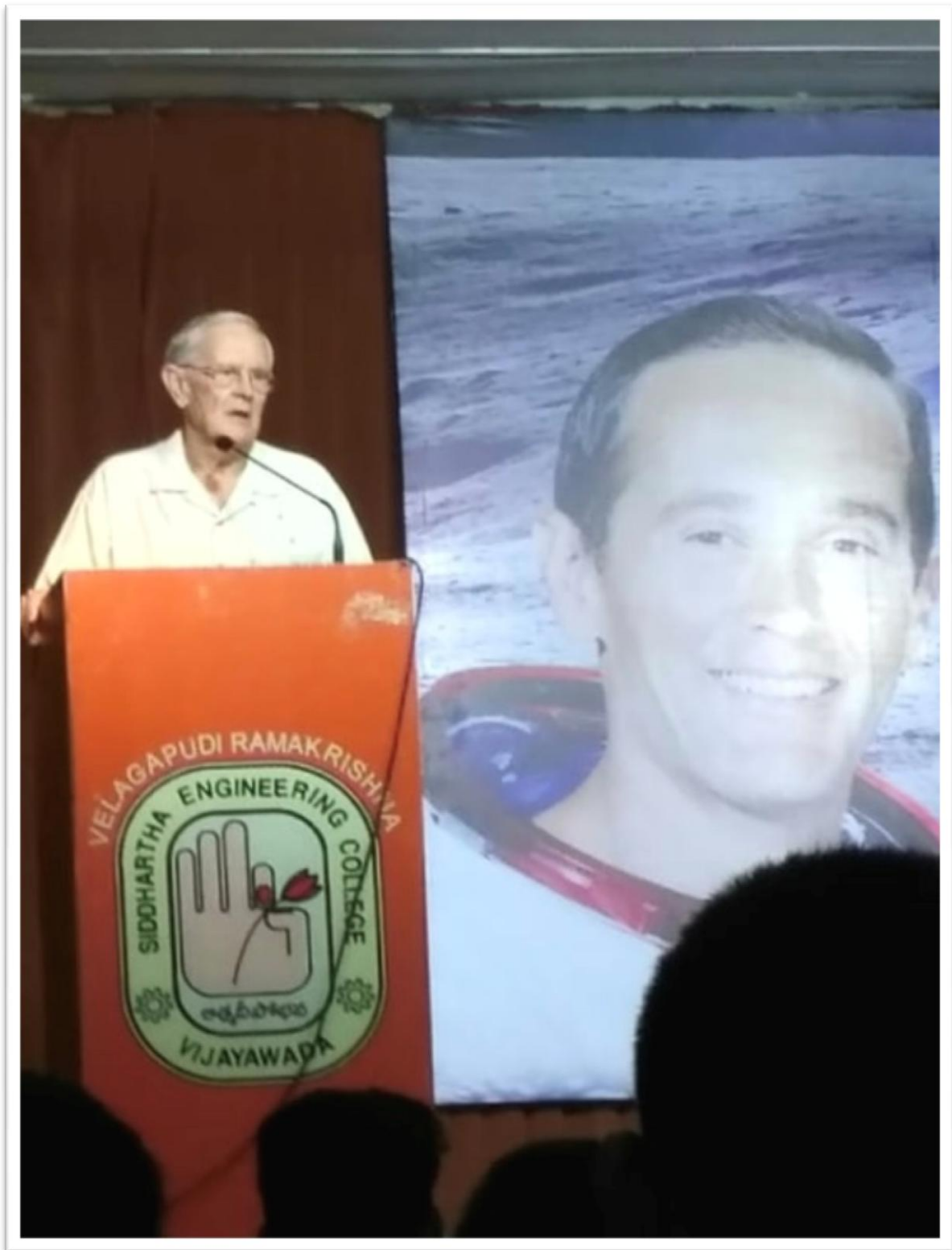
22. INTERACTION WITH Mr.CHARLES MOSS DUKE

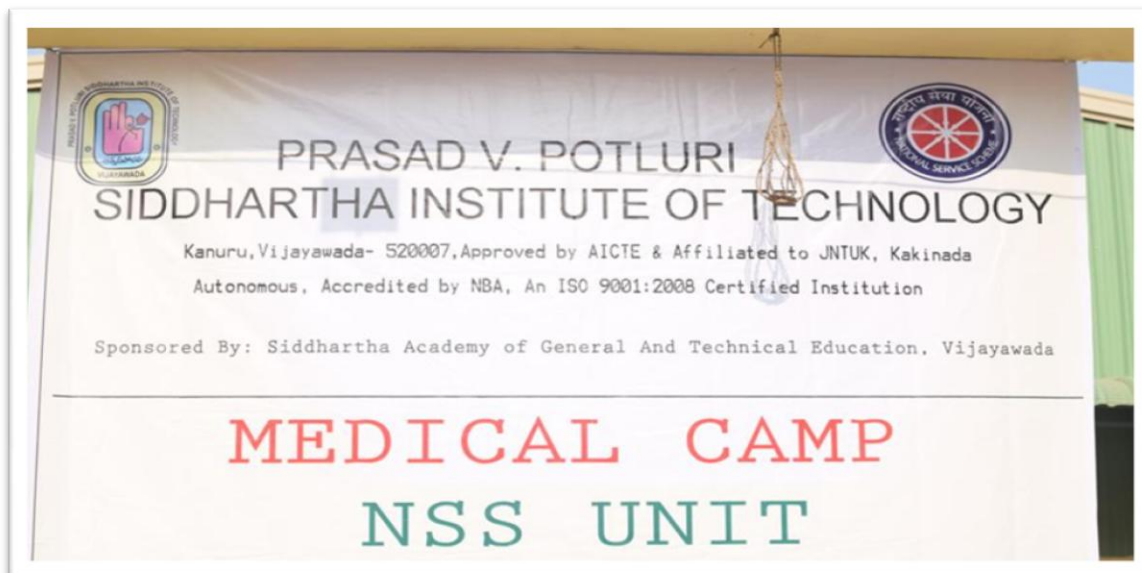
